





Relational Circle (RC) is one of the widely used universal interventions in the promotion of social and emotional learning in schools. In RC, students are encouraged to develop their social and emotional learning in a safe and caring environment through a student-directed approach.


RC is a positive experience for the whole school community with benefits such as better teacher—student relationships, positive classroom climate and various social, emotional and academic benefits for the students, including enhanced motivation and engagement in academic learning. Teachers also mentioned that it helped them to maintain positive student behaviour at both whole school and classroom levels, and reported less challenging behaviour and bullying at the school and more compliance with school and classroom rules.


